ROP REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Proficiency in the English language
- Ability to attend class scheduled dates and times
- Have access to a computer and internet for class homework (when applicable)
- Properly dressed (scrubs for Medical/ Dental classes, leather or non-synthetic material pants for welding, etc..)
- Meet all payment requirements

CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTING (CMA)

Description:

This course meets the guidelines required to sit for the Medical Assistant (CCMA) Exam hosted by the National Healthcareer Association (NHANOW.COM). It is recommended that students have previous knowledge of basic Anatomy/Physiology as well as Medical Terminology before entering the program. Upon successful completion of this course, students will be issued a Certificate of Completion and a record of all injections and blood draws.

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ONLINE "CONNECT" FOR TEXTBOOK

Connect is required to access to your instructor's homework assignments, quizzes, syllabus, notes, reminders, and other important files for the course.

IMMUNIZATION

Please complete the REQUIRED Immunization records and submit to your teacher by the 2nd week of school.

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Students must provide a copy of a completed immunization record by the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of class, including:
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Hepatitis B (1)

Hepatitis B (2)

Hepatitis B (3)

MMR (1)

MMR (2)

Varicella (injection or blood draw "titer" to prove immunity)

TB/PPD (1) within the past year

Chest x-ray (only if you had a positive TB/PPD)

TDAP

Flu Influenza vaccine (within the past year)

Students are responsible for contacting their health providers and costs associated with the immunization. Please allow time for hepatitis shot series and TB reading.

Covid-19 Directives

- Students are to provide own masks and use other PPE provided by instructor.
- Students, teacher, staff will email Director, Craig Lang at clang@edenrop.org immediately if you have documentation to show a positive COVID test.
- Students, teacher, staff will complete self-assessment forms at the beginning of each class.
- Teacher will wear mask and talk behind a shield and use PPE as needed.
- Teacher will follow procedure to intake students (temperature check and self-assessment forms).
- School will clean and sanitize classrooms and bathrooms nightly and regularly.
- School will provide sanitizer stations and hand washing sink in the classroom.
- Seating are set to follow social distancing.
- If any student testing positive for COVID will require the student's class to be postponed for two weeks before resuming in person.
- School will follow County's protocol for postponing class and/ or closing program.

CPR TRAINING

CPR Certificate for Healthcare Providers:

Our CMA Program offers CPR training at no extra cost. The CPR training is issued by the American Heart Association – Basic Life Support (BLS)/ CPR with AED for Healthcare Providers (Infant, Child, and Adult). This training is required for most employers to work in the field. You do not need to attend this training if you already have the exact CPR certification noted above and it is still valid. The training will take place during scheduled class hours.

THE CCMA EXAM (Optional)

The CCMA Exam is not required to pass the CMA class, however, it is highly recommended for employability.

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DRESS CODE


Inappropriate dress includes:
