COURSE OFFFRED:

Clinical Medical Assisting (CMA) - 5-month/ 60 class sessions \$3,300

This course meets the guidelines required to sit for the Clinical portion of the State Certified Medical Assisting Examination or the CCMA (National Exam). The course meets twice a week and additional online work is to be completed on non class days. The course is equivalent to over 360 hours of instruction and course work. Upon successful completion of this course, students will be issued a Certificate of Completion, permitting them to sit for the California Clinical Medical Assisting Exam and work as a Medical Assistant. Areas of instruction will include Anatomy/Physiology, Medical Terminology, Pharmacology, Minor Surgery, Medical Records, Clinical Skills (Vital Signs, Injections, Capillary Puncture, EKGs, etc.), Medical Asepsis/Infection Control, Career Preparation and Nutrition. Rounding out this course, students will be CPR, AED and First Aid certified, issued by the American Heart Association.

What You Will Receive: Certificate of Completion (contingent on 95% attendance and

a grade of C or better) and BLS CPR/ First Aid Certificate.

Course Cost: \$3,300 (includes a non-refundable \$70 registration fee).

Full payment or partial payment of \$1,675 is required at

registration, and \$1,650 (includes a \$25 administrative fee) is

due in four months.
