The Program:



This Coronal Polishing Class meets the Dental Board of California requirement for the Registered Dental Assistants (RDA) licensure.

Students will need to provide three (3) clinical patients to complete their final exam.



Students must pass written exam with at least 75% to complete clinical portion of class.

Student Requirements:



Patient requirement: Student is required to provide three (3) clinical patients.



Certification:

- 8-HR Infection Control Certificate
- Valid BLS (Basic Life Support)
 Certification



Attendance: is MANDATRORY, This is an hours-based course, there are Absolutely no make-up sessions.



Uniform: Students are to dress in scrubs and closed toe shoes daily.



Eyewear: students will need to provide personal protective eyewear; Eyewear must have both upper, lower, and side protection. Clear face shields are also acceptable.

Patient Requirements:

Student must provide three (3) qualified clinical patients:

- Patients must be 18+ years old.
- Patients must have at least 20 natural teeth, be in excellent health, not having any infectious diseases or the need for preventive antibiotics for the following:
 - ✓ Artificial heart valves
 - ✓ History of infective endocarditis
 - ✓ Serious congenital heart condition
 - ✓ Cardiac transplant
 - ✓ Any unrepaired or incompletely repaired heart cyanotic congenital heart disease, including those with palliative shunts and conduits.
 - ✓ Any repaired congenital heart defect with prosthetic material or device, whether by placed surgery or catheter intervention, during the first 6 months after the procedure.
 - ✓ Any repaired congenital heart defect with residual defect at the site or adjacent to the site of a prosthetic device.
