#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This Radiation Safety Class is Dental Board of California approved course for current Dental Assistants who are preparing to take the Registered Dental Assisting (RDA) Exam.

This course includes theory, preclinical (manikin practice), and clinical (patient) components. Students will gain experience in a variety of techniques, as well as exposure to digital radiography.

#### **PREREQUISITES:**

Students must provide the following TWO WEEKS BEFORE the start of the first class. Failure to do so will render the student ineligible and will not be permitted in the class.

- 8 hour Dental Infection Control Certificate
- Current BLS certification

#### **CLINICAL PATIENT REQUIREMENT:**

The clinical portion of the course will require each student to bring in four (4) patients to receive an FMX series. All patient x-rays will be done at the ROP and will be scheduled with the instructor at the first class session.

All patient x-rays must have a written paper prescription/authorization from a dentist meeting the following criteria:

- Must be on a dentist's letterhead or prescription pad.
- Must clearly state the patient's name and give authorization to complete an FMX series on that patient.
- Must have the dentist's original signature and be in pen. (No stamped signatures will be accepted)
- Must be dated and can be no more than 6 months old.
- Patient must be at least 18 years of age.
- No electronically submitted (fax, email) prescriptions will be accepted.
- Authorization/prescription CANNOT have blank areas filled in by patient or student.
- All patients will be required to show a photo ID.
- Patients must have majority of teeth present in order to obtain the required images.
- Copies of all x-rays taken on patients at the Eden Area ROP will be forwarded to the authorizing dentist.

#### **WRITTEN EXAMINATION:**

A written examination will be administered after the presentation of the theory content. Students must pass this exam in order to begin the lab or clinical components.

#### **MATERIALS:**

Students are to wear scrubs and closed-toed non-slip shoes to all class sessions. Protective eyewear is to be provided by the student and worn for all clinical procedures. All other materials and supplies will be provided by the Eden Area ROP
