The Program

- 2 days a week for 8 weeks:
 - Weeks 1-5: lectures and hands-on practice,
 - Weeks 6-8: patient care/ testing by appointment.
- Approved Dental Board of California course.
- Radiation Theory.
- Infection Control of Dental Radiography equipment.
- Practice Developing, Processing, and Mounting film.
- Preclinical laboratory practice on manikin's.
- Students will gain experience in a variety of techniques.
- Exposure to digital radiography.
- Radiography (x-ray) Certificate upon completion of four patient full mouth x-ray series on a patient.

Attendance & Punctuality: is MANDATORY, This is an hours-based course, there are no make-up sessions.
